


THINKING THROUGH A CAE QUESTION

1) Be sure to note where you are in a process!

Is the question asking about the first thing you would do? Look for a scan option of the broader environment or system.

Is the question asking what is the NEXT thing you would do? Do you need to scan again, but with a narrowed scope focused on the project defined? Or are you looking for a planning option? Implement option? Or evaluation option?

Depending on the situation offered.





2) Does the situation present an emergency or is it taking an illegal turn?

If so the CSE should exercise direct control and jump into implementation.

If not an emergency, delegate appropriately.

3) If I apply key rules of thumb, does this lead me to a particular answer?




[Scan, Plan, Implement, Evaluate (SPIE), Member-2-Member/Staff-2-Staff (M2M/S2S), Form Follows Function, Solve with the Smallest Group Possible]
